A complete set of bidding documents is available to interested Bidders on the submission of a written application to the above and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of 100 USD. The bidding documents received from the Purchaser are not transferable. The method of payment will be by Bankers Check in favor of LEC or paid in cash to the Finance Office, 1st Floor, LEC Central Office. Alternatively, a direct payment into Liberia Electricity Corporation Cash EPP No: 0011134701652405, (Swift Code No. ECOCLRLM) held with ECOBANK LIBERIA LTD and submitting the payment advice as evidence to collect the Bid Documents. The bidding documents will also be sent to the applicant electronically to the e-mail address given by the applicant for this purpose.

Bids must be delivered to the address indicated in the clause ITB 22.1 of the bidding document on or before **Tuesday, June 11, 2019 at 10:00 Hours GMT**. Late Bids will be rejected.

In the first public session, only the Qualification Documents will be opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives. In the second public session only the Bids of those Bidders who have fulfilled the qualification criteria will be opened.

All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of amount 20,000 Euro in accordance with ITB 19.1.
